

### C-2 Damashigawa River

Located on the border between Toyama and Ishikawa prefectures, Mt. lozen offers a spectacular view. On a clear day, you can see from the sankyoson scattered settlements of Tonami to Toyama bay and the Noto Peninsula. The mountain is open for climbing between April 29 and early November This river was named by Shiko Munakatta, and is also featured in one of his prints spanning 13 woodblock panels. In June, you can see the river lit up by fireflies at night.
