



D-5 The Old Toyama Prefectural Agricultural School and Important Cultural Property “Ganjokaku.”

Built in 1903, the Toyama Prefecture Agricultural School building is the only school from the Meiji period in Toyama Prefecture. The head architect in the region during the Meiji period gave this building an original design that incorporated western style to create an architectural masterpiece.

D-1 Kouyasan Shingonshu Angoji Temple

It is said that Angoji Temple was established by a monk who visited from India during the Nara period. This miraculous temple of Kannon in the Yasui region is visited not just by locals but by people from all around the world. Additionally, a nationally designated important cultural artifact, a statue of Seikannon, and a number of other cultural artifacts are preserved here.

Fukuno Gottsuo Taro Root Festival

【Held every year at the end of November】

This is a festival that is held to give thanks for the year's harvest of taro roots. There are a number of taro based meals for sale like the taro soup, dengaku, and onigiri set as well as taro croquette and taro ohagi sold separately. One of the main appeals of this festival is that you can enjoy your food while watching a live symphony orchestra or Japanese folk music.



The New Year's Great Morning Market

【Every Year December 27th】

The morning market has been around since Fukuno's founding in 1650 C.E. "The New Year's Great Morning Market" is an event held on the last day the market is open for the year and has become synonymous with the year's end in Fukuno. On the day of the festival, stores pack the main street near Fukuno station to sell various goods for New Year's like vegetables or big wooden mortars and hammers for making mochi.

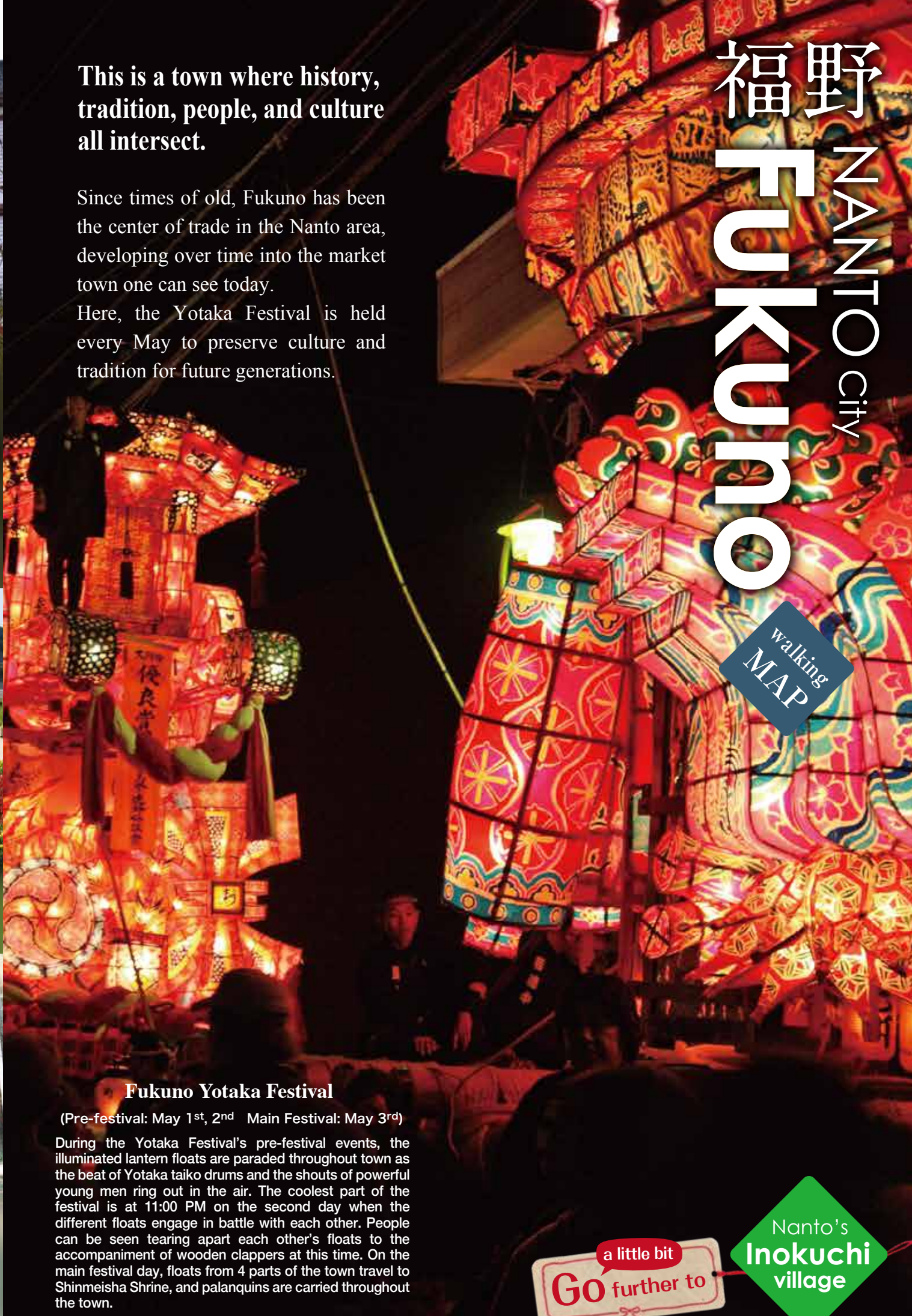

Fukuno Yotaka Festival

(Pre-festival: May 1st, 2nd Main Festival: May 3rd)

During the Yotaka Festival's pre-festival events, the illuminated lantern floats are paraded throughout town as the beat of Yotaka taiko drums and the shouts of powerful young men ring out in the air. The coolest part of the festival is at 11:00 PM on the second day when the different floats engage in battle with each other. People can be seen tearing apart each other's floats to the accompaniment of wooden clappers at this time. On the main festival day, floats from 4 parts of the town travel to Shinmeisha Shrine, and palanquins are carried throughout the town.



Sukiya Meets The World

【Held every year at the end of August】

Various artists come from all over the world to perform here in Nanto and hold workshops where people can experience things from different cultures. Additionally, there are performances from the "Sukiya Steel Drum Orchestra" and the African djembe playing percussion group "Salaam Aleikum!"



Fukuno Stripes

Originating in the Edo period, the Fukuno Stripes textile industry powered the Fukuno culture and economy throughout the Meiji, Taisho, and Showa period, until becoming obsolete in the 1970s. Today, the Fukuno Stripes Society seeks to revive the technique, and produces a variety of handwoven items.

A-4 Inokuchi Camellia Center

The "Original Strain Camellia Garden" here has been highly praised for its scholarly value; there are roughly 110 different genus of camellias from countries like China and Vietnam being raised in the garden. The center is especially known for its globally valuable collection of 30 different strains of chrysanthemum-camellias. The building is white and black as a basic theme with a modern interior design to make a super fashionable and chic center. The lobby is also comfortable to stay in, and the event hall is great for exhibitions and a variety of other events.

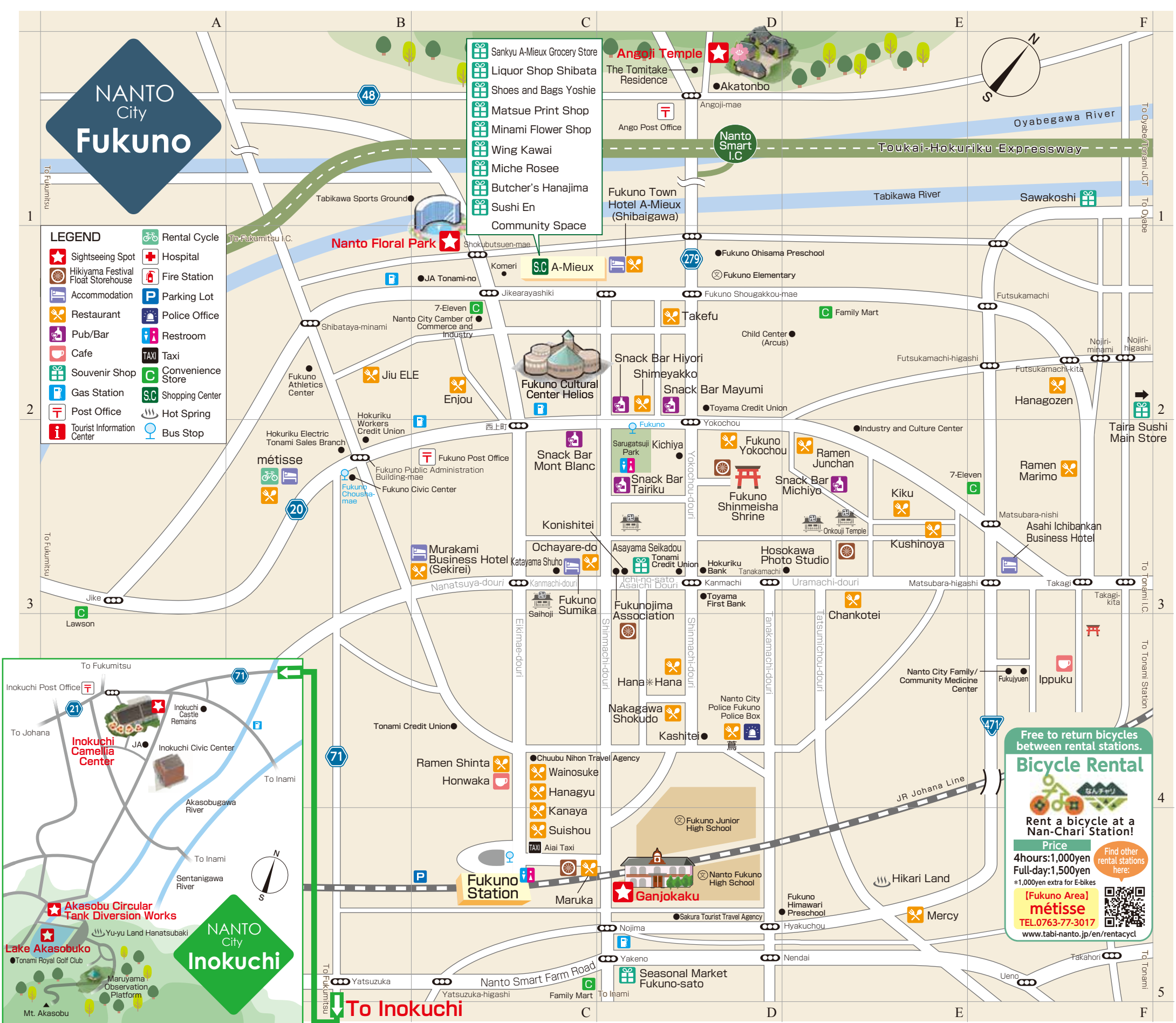
A-5 Lake Akasobuko

A-5 Akasobu Circular Tank Diversion Works

Akasobu Reservoir's circular tank diversion works is a piece of infrastructure that takes the stored water from the reservoir and uniformly distributes it for irrigation without the need for any human assistance. The sight of water pouring from the circular tank is beautiful and definitely worth checking out.
